We push our vans to the limits by transporting dogs and cats all over Central Texas. These vehicles save lives but require fuel and care. The overall average cost to maintain, fuel, insure, and repair our vehicles is \$145 a week.

Thanks to the heroic efforts of WAGS Hope and Healing, sixty-four desperate animals were rescued and transferred to PAWS.



These resilient dogs came to us in need of varying degrees of medical care. Many tested positive for heartworms which requires an expensive treatment that has exhausted our medical budget. 
