PAWS Shelter of Central Texas (PAWS) was founded in Kyle, Texas in 1986 as a 501 (c) 3 non-profit organization providing care and love to homeless, abandoned, and abused animals in Central Texas. We are a no-kill shelter that believes in second chances! At PAWS, companion animals are given medical attention, care, and love for however long it takes for us to find them a loving home.

PAWS is relentless in our effort to save lives and change lives. Our efforts in that regard include:

- Holding offsite adoptions to get the animals out into the community.
- Fully vaccinating and microchipping our animals so that they can begin their long, happy lives with their new owners, "fully equipped!".
- Visiting local community groups and schools to educate our community on responsible pet ownership.
- Making sure that every animal in our care gets the medical attention it needs.
- Implementing a Behavior Testing Program which temperament tests all those in our care before they are adopted into the community, allowing for better placement of pets into a new home environment that is best for all.
- Spaying or neutering all our animals to further our commitment to be part of the solution in our communities' pet overpopulation problem.

Vision:

PAWS was gifted 39 beautiful acres of property on Highway 165 between Blanco and Dripping Springs by a very generous cat and dog loving donor, Shirley Alexander. With this land, PAWS has sufficient land to build a new facility with approximately 7,000 square feet of air-conditioned space and an additional 2,300 square feet of covered areas. Ultimately, the new shelter will encompass a complete campus of walking trails, a memorial garden and areas for dog training.

Since PAWS Shelter of Central Texas opened its doors to care for the abandoned and stray animals of Hays County and Central Texas over a quarter century ago, the area has experienced explosive growth in both human and animal populations. The new "No-Kill" shelter will allow us to greater serve the Hays and Blanco County animal populations by providing homeless dogs and cats shelter and health care while loving, permanent homes are found for them.

The PAWS Hill Country Shelter is destined to be a true celebration of the human-animal bond, a place where we can continue our efforts to end animal neglect, cruelty, abuse and abandonment and begin love for all involved.
